Through two summers of research at Hofstra University, I analyzed EEG and ECG data in R to study seizure detection and arrhythmia detection and presented my findings. My clinical service spans a free clinic for uninsured patients at RotaCare NY, family support at Ronald McDonald House, and volunteering at North Shore University Hospital, with physician shadowing in oncology deepening my understanding of medicine. Leading my school's Muslim Student Association and serving as Medical Club secretary have built organization and teamwork, and competing on my school's volleyball and baseball teams has reinforced discipline and leadership. Across research, service, and academics, I aim to apply science to improve lives.

Volunteer, RotaCare NY Free Clinic | Hempstead, New York

- Support a free clinic delivering primary and specialty care to uninsured and low income patients across Nassau County
- Assist with patient intake, registration, and navigation during clinic sessions
- Adhere to strict patient confidentiality, safety, and health protocols
- Collaborate with volunteer physicians, nurses, and staff in a direct patient care environment

Summer 2026

Research, Hofstra University | Hempstead, New York

- Built an arrhythmia (irregular heartbeat) detection program in R using the MIT-BIH Arrhythmia Database of real, cardiologist-labeled patient ECG recordings
- Measured the timing between heartbeats to teach the program to tell normal rhythms apart from abnormal ones
- Uncovered a key evaluation pitfall: accuracy appeared **97.3%** under standard testing but was **79.6%** when tested on patients it had never seen — a 17.7-point gap showing a tool must generalize to new patients to be useful in a hospital
- Presented findings at a research poster session (August 2026); mentored by Dr. Antonios Marsellos

July 2026

Physician Shadowing, LMG Cancer & Infusion Center | Loudoun County, Virginia

- Shadowed Dr. Syed Salman Ali, board certified oncologist and hematologist, during a one week intensive observership
- Observed 35+ patient consultations spanning breast, lung, colon, pancreatic, prostate, and bladder cancers plus blood disorders including CML, CLL, lymphoma, multiple myeloma, and polycythemia vera
- Studied treatment planning across chemotherapy, immunotherapy, antibody-drug conjugates, hormone therapy, and tyrosine kinase inhibitors in an outpatient infusion center
- Kept a daily reflection journal on physician communication and clinical decision making, including how difficult diagnoses are delivered with a concrete next step
- Invited to return each summer to continue the observership and build a multi-year clinical mentorship

- Selected for the **Youth Ambassador Program** (September 2026 – June 2027), a year-long leadership cohort supporting fundraising, advocacy, and community outreach
